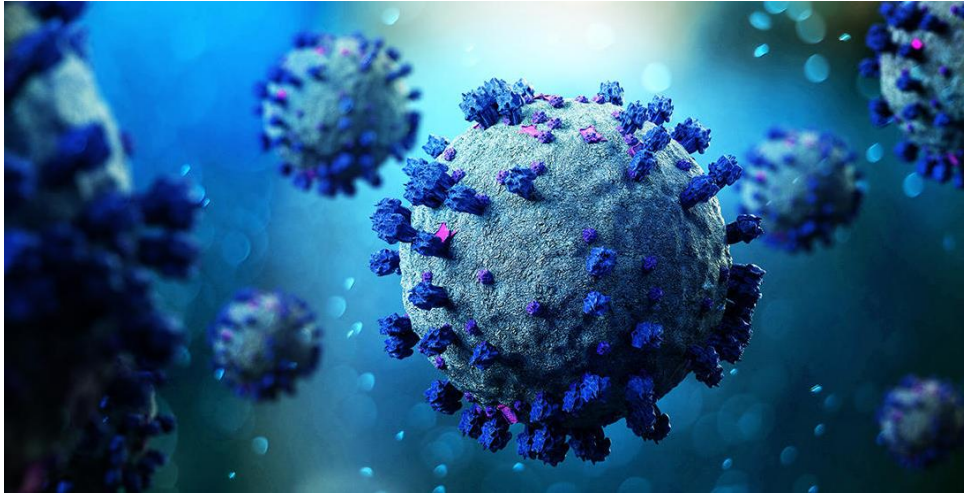


COVID -19 Blogs
